Have you ever heard of the WPA?

The Works Progress Administration (WPA) was a program begun in order to put many of the 15,000,000 unemployed people to work. They were builders of schools, court houses, museums, dams, river walks, sidewalks, curbs, buildings for organizations, parks and playgrounds. Paid \$18.75 a week by the government, they worked long hours. (So many people were out of work during the 1930's that it has been called the Great Depression.) The WPA workers put in many of the sidewalks in downtown Silver City!
