

How to Complete: Core Experiential Learning Program Selection and School-to-Museum Transportation Application (PK-5th Grade Teachers in Grant County only)

Core Experiential Learning Program (CELP) Selection To select the museum-specific (WNMU Museum or Silver City Museum) on-site Core Experiential Learning Program (CELP) for your PK-5th grade class, please visit the Transport to the Past: Museum Adventures in Archaeology and History section of each museum's website (WNMU Museum: www.wnmuseum.org and Silver City Museum: www.silvercitymuseum.org). Each museum's website provides a description of the on-site CELP options available at that institution and downloadable PDFs of the associated CELP-specific Teacher Resources: Teacher Resource Guide and pre- and post-visit grade appropriate activities.

On-site Core Experiential Learning Programs are offered by both museums to Grant County Schools only Tuesday through Friday, except holidays or closures, and CELP start time must be between 9:00 am and 11:00 am unless noted otherwise on CELP information.

Once you have made a choice of museum and CELP, please complete the *Core Experiential Learning Program (CELP) Selection and School-to-Museum Transport Application* in its entirety. Only complete the School-to-Museum Transport section your school is not within what your school's administration determines as appropriate walking distance of the Museum selected (WNMU Museum or Silver City Museum) Core Experiential Learning Program (CELP) for your PK-5th grade class. One of the critical components of the ***Transport to the Past: Museum Adventures in Archaeology and History*** project funded by Freeport McMoRan Foundation is to eliminate the school-to-museum transport barrier for PreK-5th grade classes throughout Grant County. Sufficient funds have been allotted to ensure that each PreK-5th grade class in Grant County can attend one CELP at *each museum*, WNMU Museum and the Silver City Museum, during the 2014-2015 academic year.
