Your free admission carries with it the responsibility for your assigned group during your visit.

Being a Chaperone

- Please stay with students who have been assigned to you. The Museum requires that students stay with their adult chaperones, regardless of the age of the student. (5 - 10 students per chaperone).
- Chaperones are responsible for the proper behavior of their group at all times.

Helpful Hints for Chaperones

- Learn the names of the students in your group; make sure they know your name.
- Be aware of your groups schedule
- Focus your group on the educational purpose of your visit by asking them questions and getting them involved.
- Keep your group together while moving through each exhibit area.
- If you have any questions, ask a staff person for help.

Student Responsibilities and Expectations

- Respect other students, visitors, museum staff, and museum property.
- There is no food, drink, or gum allowed in the museum under any circumstances.
- Please do not run, use loud voices, use foul language, push or throw things.
- Some things in the museum can be touched, some things can't. Signs, staff members, or volunteers will let you know when it's okay to touch.

Behavior: In the instance of disruptive behavior

- Teacher and/or chaperone must take action to resolve the situation.
- If the behavior persists the museum reserves the right to ask the student(s) or group to leave.
